Travelling to New Zealand

Passport

Passport required.

Passport Exemptions:

Nationals of Philippines with an emergency passport.

Document Validity:

Passports and other documents accepted for entry issued to nationals of Philippines must be valid for a minimum of 1 month beyond the period of intended stay.

Minors:

Minors entering New Zealand may be included in the passport of the parent, who is traveling with them.

Warning:

Passengers with an APEC Business Travel Card must travel with a passport. The passport number and nationality must match those stated on the card.

Visa

Visa required.

Visa Exemptions:

Passengers with an APEC Business Travel Card valid for travel to "NZL" if traveling on business for a maximum stay of 3 months. The card is valid for the countries listed on the back of the card.

Additional Information:

Visitors are required to hold proof of sufficient funds to cover their stay. The amount of funds needed is NZD 1,000.- per person per month of stay or NZD 400.- if accommodation has been prepaid. Evidence of funds may be in the form of cash, traveler's cheques, bank drafts, letters of credit or the following credit cards: Diners Club, American Express, Bankcard, Mastercard and Visa. If Visa label contains "Funds Waived", evidence of sufficient funds is not required.

All passengers (except residents of Tokelau) must obtain a permit to enter Tokelau from the Tokelau Apia Liaison Office in Apia, at least 2 weeks prior to travel. Tel: 685 20822. Fax: 685 21761. Tokelau can only be reached by boat from Samoa. A permit from the Samoan Immigration Authorities is required to leave and re-enter Samoa.

Warning:

Passengers with a passport with an Australian citizen or a New Zealand citizen endorsement do not require a New Zealand Electronic Travel Authority (NZeTA).

Visitors holding a visa that specifies the requirement to hold an outward ticket must hold return/onward tickets. **Exception:** This does not apply to holders of authorization issued by New Zealand's immigration authorities waiving the return ticket requirement.

Visa required.

TWOV (Transit Without Visa):

Nationals of Philippines transiting through Perth (PER) with a confirmed onward ticket for a flight to a third country within 8 hours. They must stay in the international transit area of the airport and have documents required for the next destination.

- TWOV does not apply when transiting between T1/T2 and T3/T4 at Perth (PER).

Nationals of Philippines transiting through Cairns (CNS) or Sydney (SYD) with a confirmed onward ticket for a flight to a third country within 8 hours on the same calendar day. They must stay in the international transit area of the airport and have documents required for the next destination.

Nationals of Philippines transiting through Adelaide (ADL) with a confirmed onward ticket for a flight to a third country within 8 hours on the same calendar day. When transiting on different aircraft, the airline must give advance notice. They must have documents required for the next destination.

Nationals of Philippines transiting through Gold Coast (OOL) with a confirmed onward ticket for a flight to a third country within 2 hours or arriving and departing on the same aircraft. They must stay in the international transit area of the airport and have documents required for the next destination.

Nationals of Philippines transiting through Brisbane (BNE), Darwin (DRW) or Melbourne (MEL) with a confirmed onward ticket for a flight to a third country within 8 hours. They must stay in the international transit area of the airport and have documents required for the next destination.

Additional Information:

Airlines can verify the status of an electronic visa holder by using Australia's Advance Passenger Processing (APP) system before boarding the aircraft. Verification by airlines using Australia's Advance Passenger Processing (APP) system will require the details of the travel document that the visa is issued against.
